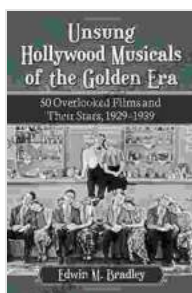

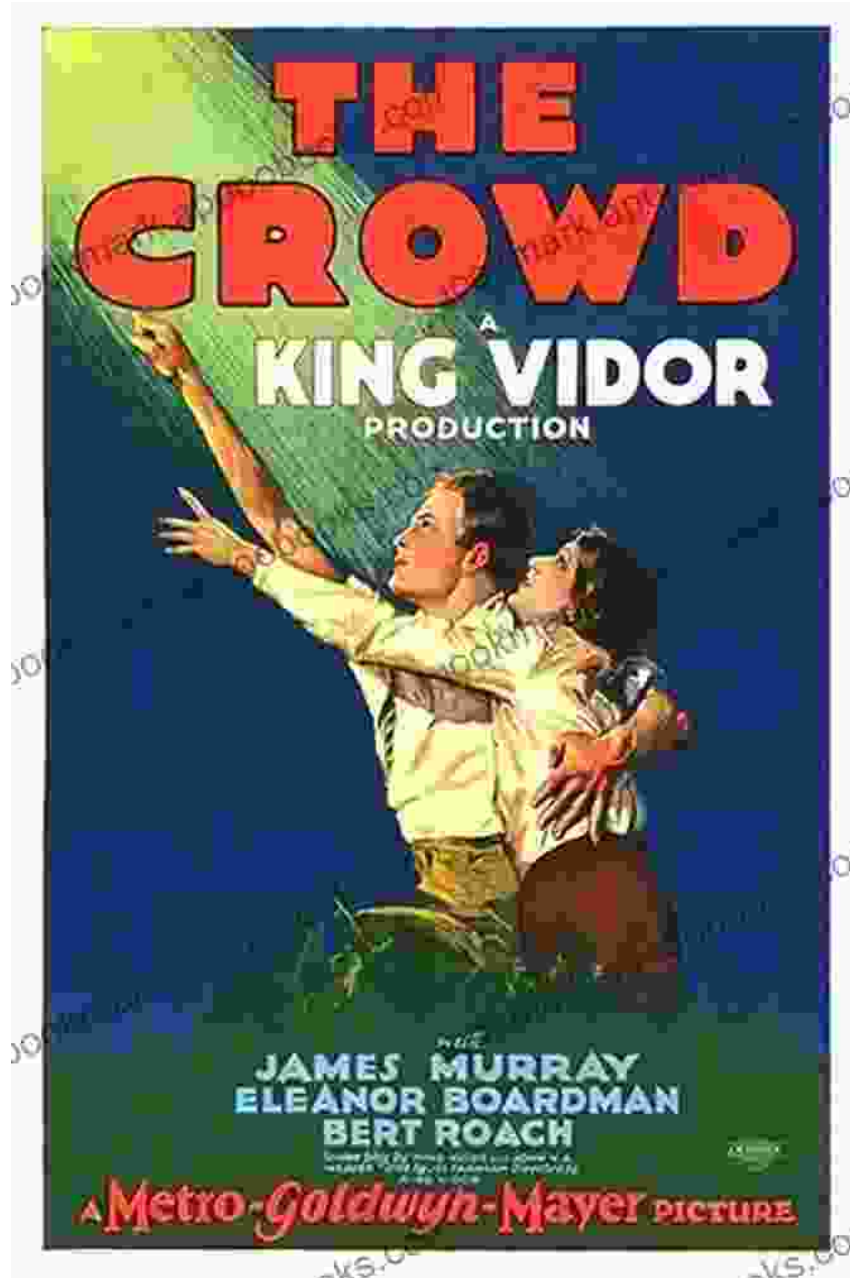

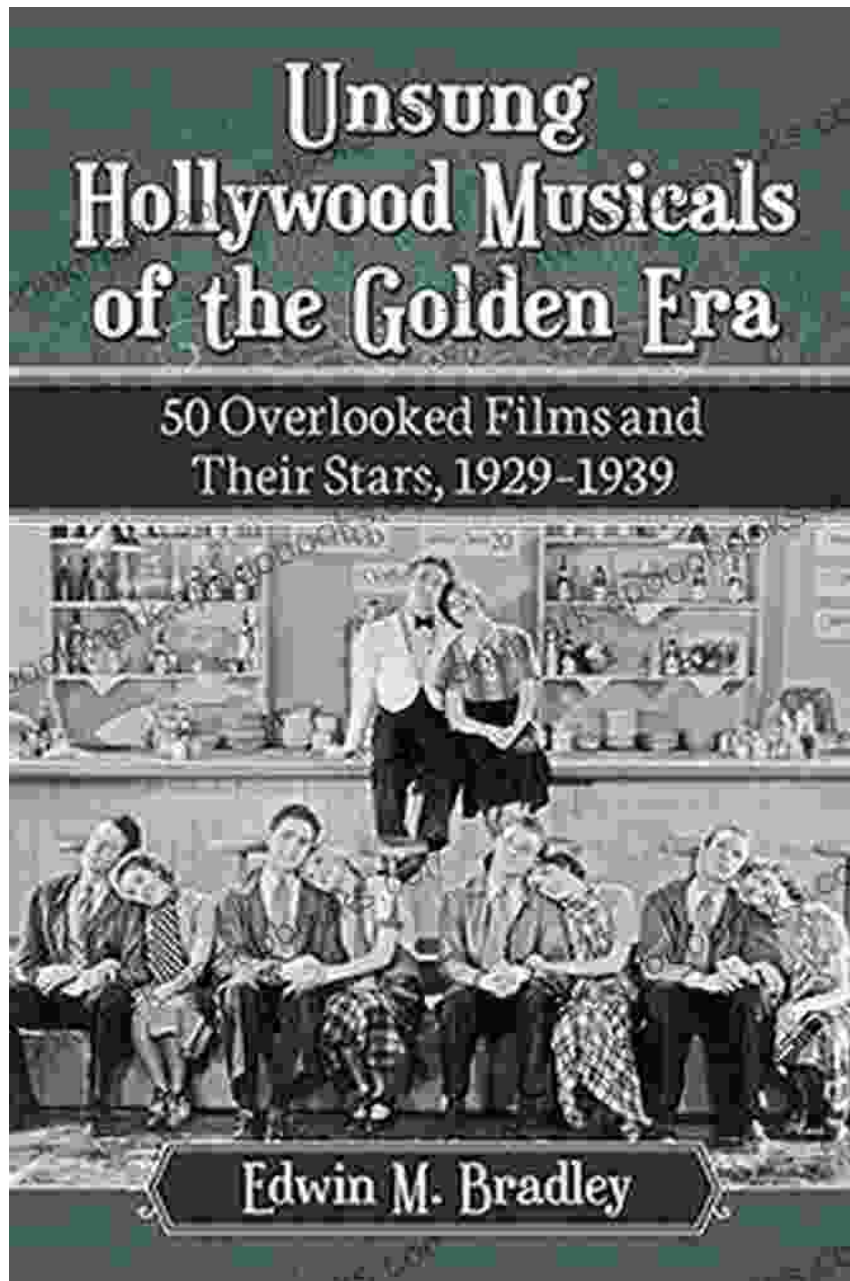


### 1. The Crowd (1928)



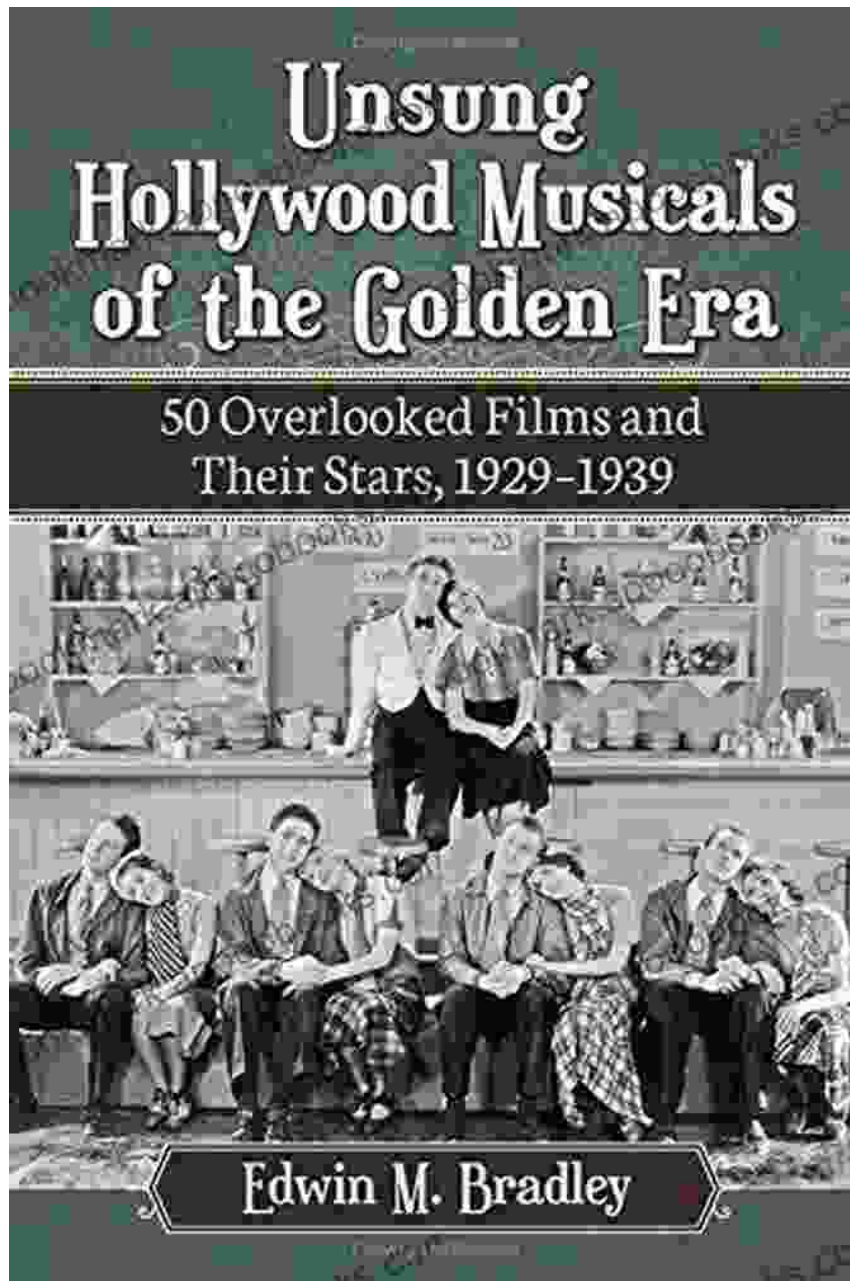

## 2. King Vidor (1894-1982)



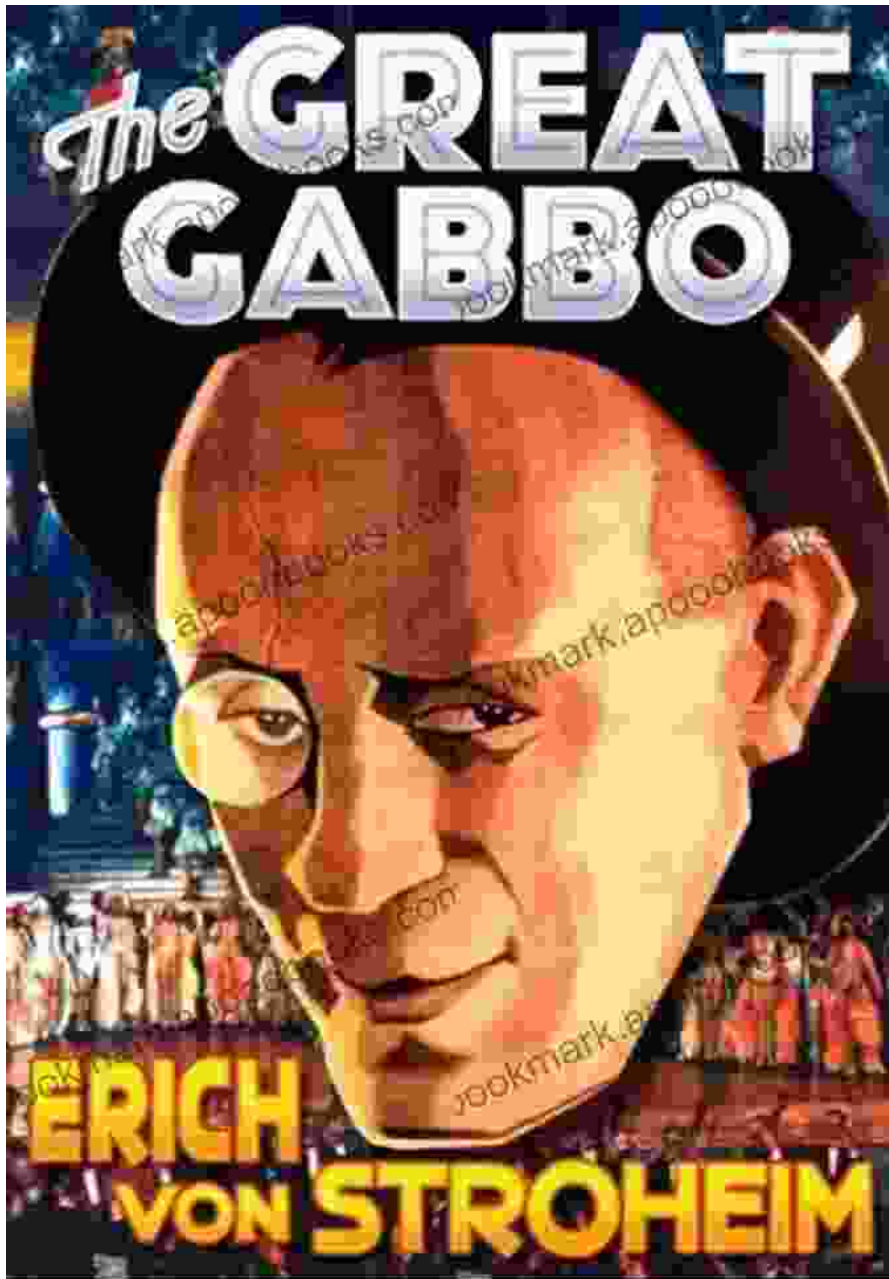

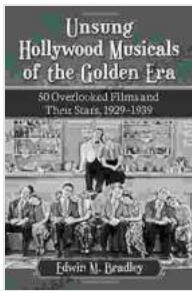
#### **4. The Great Gabbo (1929)**

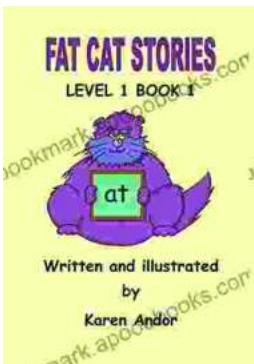

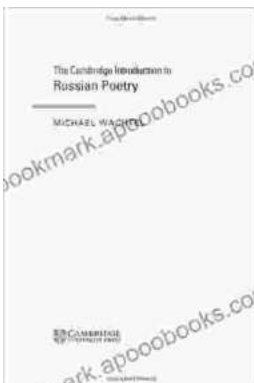
